Payments: All fees must accompany entry. No postdated checks will be accepted. Online or faxed entries must be paid in full within ten days of receipt or prior to the start of the show, whichever is first. Please make checks payable to "Houston Cat Club Charity Cat Show" or HCCCCS. **If championship cats or kittens are entered in addition to premiership cats, they will be considered the first two entries for purposes of calculating the entry fee. There will be no refund after the entry clerk has confirmed your entry or for failure to bench. Check your confirmation for accuracy and contact the entry clerk with any corrections before the closing date.**

Show Hall: The show hall has heating or air conditioning as appropriate. Food is available, no outside food allowed. No alcoholic beverages allowed. Smoking is not permitted in the show hall. The show hall is handicapped accessible. Exhibitors with handicaps are responsible for making their special needs known to the entry clerk.

Show Hours: Saturday from 9:00am to 5:00pm; Sunday from 9:00am to 4:00pm or until judging is complete. Check-in Saturday is 7:30am to 8:30am. Friday setup will be allowed from 1:00pm to 5:00pm. Exhibitors arriving late on Saturday and have already been marked absent in the catalog will have to notify each ring that they are present. Entries (except kittens) may not be removed from the show hall prior to the completion of judging without the permission of the show manager.

Show Hotel: Hilton Houston North, 12400 Greenspoint Dr., Houston, Texas, 77060. \$89/night, King or two Queen beds. The \$100 pet fee will be refunded AFTER checkout. **For reservations in our block, go to: www.my-event.hilton.com/hougphf-cat-1352fe59-d090-4685-9eda-9fc9302a02e0/ To get the special rate if you call the hotel (281-875-2222), please identify yourself as being part of the Houston Cat Club 69th Annual Charity Cat Show and specify accommodations (King, Queen, or Double).**

Scoring: All entries in Championship (except Novice), Premiership (except Novice), registered Kittens, recorded Household Pets, and registered cats competing as Household Pets with a Household Pet color class prefix will be scored for CFA awards. Owners of cats/kittens without registration numbers can contact the entry clerk for a Temporary Registration Number."

Health: This is a non-vetted show. It is strongly advised that all entries be inoculated against feline panleukopenia, feline rhinotracheitis, calici viruses, and **rabies**. It is also strongly recommended that cats be tested and found negative for FeLV and FIV. All entries must be free of fleas, fungus, and ear mites. The show committee reserves the right to remove any cat or kitten from the show hall if suspected of having any of the above conditions until examined by a veterinarian at the owner's or agent's expense. Entries' claws must be clipped on all four feet. **Declawed cats and kittens under the age of 4 months not permitted in the show hall.**

Cages and Supplies: Exhibitors must provide their own benching enclosure. Single cage spots are 22"X22"X22" and double cage spots are 22"X22"X45". A few popups tents will be available to purchase for \$20. Please inform the entry clerk if you need one. **Security cage for single entry requires purchase of extra half cage.** Benching requests made at time of entry will be honored when possible. Bring your own cat food, dishes, and litter pans - litter will be provided.

Liability: Reasonable care of cats and other property will be provided. However, neither The Houston Cat Club nor Hilton Houston North will be liable for any loss or damage to a cat, exhibitor, or their personal property. **No cats may be left in the show hall overnight.**

Airport: George Bush Intercontinental (IAH). IAH is about 9 miles from the show hotel/hall. It takes 10-15 minutes to make the trip and the Hilton has shuttle service. We recommend that you do **NOT** fly into Hobby Airport (HOU), which is 24 miles from the show hotel/hall. The trip takes at least 35 minutes and can be more than an hour when traffic is bad, which it usually is most of the time!

Household Pets: Household Pets are judged in all 10 rings (all allbreed). Contact Toni Huff at toni.huff3969@yahoo.com or 936-222-8319. **Household Pets will be inspected at check in. Toygers, Serengetis, Savannahs, and Chausies are not permitted in the show hall, will not be benched, and the entry fee will not be refunded.**
